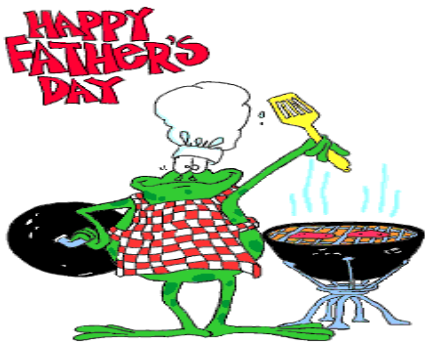

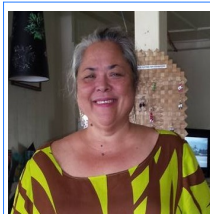

A few words from Hale Hulu Mamo By Sheila Roback

Hale Hulu Mamo is privileged to offer the Kupuna of Hana a number of wonderful activities to help them socially, physically, culturally, spiritually and emotionally. One of our Center's most popular activities is Lomilomi (Hawaiian massage). Three times a week we have massage therapists come in for one-hour long sessions. They are able to work on Kupuna with 12 sessions each week. We try to meet the demands of our Kupuna and offer each Kupuna a monthly appointment. It is always a joy to watch them come out of the Lomilomi room with their hair tousled and a look of sheer bliss on their faces.

Another popular activity is "Aqua-cise" which takes place on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday at the Travaasa Hotel Hana Infinity pool; Jody Klein and Bob Williams facilitate these classes with laughter and splashing permeating the air. Some of the Kupuna who attend are recovering from knee and shoulder surgery and have been most grateful to have this program available for them. Others just enjoy this time to socialize, exercise and splash away a few emotional stresses in their life. We also have Acupuncture twice a month with Peter Murakami who is also a Chinese Herbalist. Our Kupuna learn a lot about how their body works and the limitation of movement due to certain physical challenges in their lives.
